

Front panel



Instructions of use

- 1. Connect the power supply via the rear panel.
- 2. Connect the accessories properly to the front/rear panel as indicated in the sketch.



Accesory connection

Number	Accessorie/connection
1	Body electrode holder wire
2	Negative plate wire
3	Face electrode holder wire
4	Negative plate
5	Face electrodes
6	Body electrodes
7	"POWER" button
8	Power cord

- 3. Turn on the "POWER" button.
- **4.** Press "SELECT" button to choose the desired electrode holder (face or body). The display will show the electrode holder that is working.
- **5.** Put the negative plate in contact with a large surface of the skin. It must be close to the treatment zone.

Note: to avoid burning to the customer, never forget to put this plate in contact with the skin.

- **6.** Choose the desired electrode according to the treatment. Depending the treatment zone is needed to choose an electrode of a proper size.
- 7. Apply enough gel or cream in the treatment zone.
- 8. Press "START/PAUSE" button to start the treatment.
- 9. Choose the wave state according the customer need. Is recommended firstly choose discontinuous wave (for sensitive skins). Then, you can choose the other wave states according to the customer need/feelings and according to the discretion of the beautician.
- 10. Apply the electrodes on the customer's skin making constantly circles, without stopping of making movements. Not keep the electrode without moving at the same zone during a long period of time, the customer could be burned.
- **11.** Once the treatment has finished press "START/PAUSE" button.

Notes and precautions

- Radiofrequency treatments must not extend over a long period of time. The recommended duration is 10 minutes for facial treatments and 20 minutes for body treatments. In any case, treatments extend beyond 60 minutes.
- To avoid burning to the customer, never forget to put this plate in contact with the skin.
- Apply the electrodes on the customer's skin making constantly circles, without stopping of making movements. Not keep the electrode without moving at the same zone during a long period of time, the customer could be burned.
- Don't forget to apply gel or cream in the treatment zone.

Secondary effects and contraindications

The secondary effects of the radiofrequency are:

- Redness and swelling after the session (are transient, but usually present).
- Some small ecchymosis (rare).

The radiofrequency treatment is contraindicated in:

- Pregnancy and lactation.
- Metal prostheses or pacemakers.
- Serious heart defects.
- Coagulation disorders.
- Connective tissue diseases and neuromuscular.
- Cancer.
- Patients with overweight.
- Recent collagen implants.
